SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM RULES: Stanley Gold Florida State NAPS Scholarship

Each academic year NAPS Florida State will offer two \$1,000.00 college scholarships to the children and grandchildren or FL NAPS members who will attend college on a "full time" basis, In 2021 the State Board voted to rename the scholarship in memory of Stanley Gold. In June 2024 Amount was increased to \$1,000.

The Scholarship(s) will be available for enrollment to an accredited 2- or 4-year institution to any member in good standing of Florida State NAPS and/or family member.

The Scholarship Committee will be comprised of five members and will be created prior to the State/Bi-State convention as appointed by the State President. The scholarship applications must be submitted/postmarked no later than May 1 to the State Secretary Treasurer. All personal information will be redacted from the applications and copies sent committee members for review prior to the convention. Winners to be announced at the State Convention.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH EACH COMPLETED APPLICATION, or the application will not be considered:

- 1. Applicant's relationship to the FL State NAPS Member and Branch number.
- 2. The NAPS member's mailing address.
- 3. Applicants proof of enrollment to an accredited 2- or 4-year institution,
- 4. A brief essay of 200 words or less on: What Major I plan to pursue in college.
- 5. Applications must be submitted or postmarked by May 1 for consideration.
- 6. Any application submitted not meeting the requirements will be disqualified.

A report by the Committee Chairman will be submitted to the State Board at the June Board Meeting. The report will include the number of applications received for consideration.

Recipients of the award(s) must register in a college, university, or technical college no later than September of the year in which the scholarship is awarded or forfeit the award.

Funding the Scholarship Program will be paid for by the State Branch 911. The Scholarship Committee will announce the two winning applicants at the State Convention in June and will issue the checks as soon as possible thereafter.
